



## Exam Format

The exam will contain each of the following sections:

- Section I. will consist of reading comprehension--Poetry (3 points each question for a total of 12 points)
  - “Mutability” by Percy Bysshe Shelley
  - Questions will focus on form, literary techniques, theme, and correlations between the poem and the novel
- Section II. will consist of reading comprehension--Non-Fiction passage (3 points each for a total of 6 points)
  - “The Modern Prometheus” by Craig Lowell, Ph.D.
  - Questions will focus on correlations that can be made between the article and the novel, vocabulary in context, and reading comprehension
- Section III. will consist of reading comprehension--literary work (3 points each for a total of 45 points)
  - *Frankenstein* by Mary Shelley
  - Questions will focus on reading comprehension skills you built throughout the unit that came both from your QCOPs and our class discussions.
- Section IV. will consist of character identification (3 points each for a total of 27 points)
  - You will select the character from a list who is best described
  - You may choose each character more than once
- Section V. will focus on reading comprehension--short story (3 points each for a total of 9 points)
  - “A New Life” by Ramsey Campbell
  - Questions will focus on your interpretation of the story, direct correlations to the literature, and relevant points made during our Out of the Box activity.
